2025 YEAR OF JUBILEE - PILGRIMS OF HOPE: Pope Francis has declared that 2025 will be a year of Jubilee. A Jubilee happens every 25 years and is a special opportunity for coming closer to Our Lord Jesus Christ. The Church grants special graces called Plenary Indulgences during the Jubilee Year. These graces can be for your own soul or the Holy Souls in purgatory. **Our Lady of Light Church, Clacton on Sea, has been designated as a Sacred Place of Pilgrimage for the Jubilee Year.** You can obtain the Plenary Indulgence by visiting the church and participating in the Holy Mass, Rosary, Stations of the Cross or Expositions. You need to say a personal prayer for the Pope. You also need to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation within 20 days of the visit. You can receive one Plenary Indulgence each day. Full details of all services are available at: https://ourladyoflight.uk/

PLENARY INDULGENCES AND STATIONS OF THE CROSS: The Church offers a plenary indulgence (the removal of all temporal punishment due to sin) to those who piously pray the Stations of the Cross. These are the conditions for the indulgence:

- You must participate in the devotion piously, either publicly or privately.
- The Stations must be legitimate stations with 14 crosses, representing the stations of Jerusalem.
- You must meditate on the Passion and Death of Jesus.
- You must move from one Station to another, or if taking part in a public devotion, the leader must do so.
- If you are housebound or otherwise unable to visit legitimate Stations, you may
 acquire the indulgence by piously meditating on the Stations for at least 15
 minutes.
- The normal conditions of an indulgence: Confession, Holy Communion, an Our Father for the Pope's intentions, and being completely detached from sin.
