The Treasure We Have Found

Solomon prayed for the wisdom to discern the true value of things. We scarcely need the wisdom of Solomon to realise that in finding the love of God we have found a treasure beyond price. It is in the joy of this realisation that we hold our celebration today.

We would respectfully ask that you please ensure that all mobile phones are switched off while you are in church.

FR JON WRITES: Happily, I continue to receive further requests/registrations for Mass allocations as people feel more and more confident about returning to church. I am also pleased to say that a good number of those returning are people who were previously part of a 'Garden Communion' group. As the need for these groups diminishes (though some, of course, still continue) I am very much aware that there are those who are not yet ready, or able to come back **into** church. I am anxious that no one should be denied the opportunity to receive Communion. Accordingly, I am considering an outdoor, or 'open air' Mass, behind the church hall. This would be at 12noon on Saturdays. – As this would involve some financial expense, as well as considerable organisation, I invite those who think they would be interested in attending such an outdoor Mass to contact me, so as I may gauge the need/desire.

If you haven't yet made your request, or are unsure about returning to church, for whatever reason, I am happy to talk through any anxieties or questions. – I would remind those who just haven't got around to writing in that, in compliance with the Government's 'Track & Trace' requirements, it is mandated that people must register before they can attend. As I said in previous weeks, if you are not registered, you CANNOT come to Mass! So, please write or email your preference as soon as you can.

I believe I have contacted all those who have written or emailed their requests, confirming their Mass allocations, but if you have not received a reply from me, I'm sorry, just send me a reminder. Please note that families of up to 5, and living in the same house, may sit together on a single pew.

Notwithstanding all of the above, it is important to reaffirm that at present, the obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains suspended. Also, Sunday and Weekday Masses are of equal significance.

Please note that all toilets will be closed. Also, you are requested to remain in your seat throughout Mass. Baskets for your offerings are placed at both the entrance and exit to the church.

Anyone displaying symptoms of Covid-19, or who has any reason to believe that they have been in contact with someone who has, should not attend church or volunteer in any capacity until they have received medical advice that it is safe to do so.

HOME COMMUNION: As the more vulnerable members of our parish will not be able to attend Mass in church due to shielding, Fr Jon will continue to bring Communion to groups of up to five, in open areas and private gardens (weather permitting).
