1st Reading:

Responsorial Psalm *R/. Send forth your Spirit, O Lord, and renew the face of the earth.*

2nd Reading:
Romans 8: 8-17 Everyone moved by the Spirit is a son of God.

Gospel Acclamation: *R/. Alleluia, alleluia! Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. R/. Alleluia!*

Gospel Reading:
John 14:15-16-23-26 The Holy Spirit will teach you everything.
