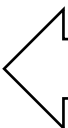

Christ Our Peace

The peace of Christ which we celebrate today should leave its mark on us so that we become messengers of peace to all around us.

Entrance Antiphon: Your merciful love, O God, we have received in the midst of your temple. Your praise, O God, like your name, reaches the ends of the earth; your right hand is filled with saving justice. alleluia.

1st Reading:
Isaiah 66: 10-14 Towards her I send flowing peace, like a river.

Responsorial Psalm **R/. Cry out with joy to God all the earth**

2nd Reading:
Galatians 6: 14-18 The marks on my body are those of the Lord Jesus.

Gospel Acclamation: **R/. Alleluia, alleluia!**
I call you friends, says the Lord, because I have made known to you everything I have learnt from my Father.

Gospel Reading:
Luke 10:1-12, 17-20 Your peace will rest on that man.
