The mystery of today's celebration is Christ among us as our friend. We welcome him as Abraham welcomed the Lord at Mamre, and Martha and Mary welcomed Christ at Bethany.

Entrance Antiphon: See, I have God for my help. The Lord sustains my soul. I will sacrifice to you with willing heart, and praise your name, O Lord, for it is good. alleluia.

1st Reading:
Genesis: 18: 1-10 Lord, do not pass your servant by.

Responsorial Psalm *R/. The just will live in the presence of the Lord.*

2nd Reading:
Colossians 1: 24-28 A mystery hidden for centuries has now been revealed to God's saints.

Gospel Acclamation: *R/. Alleluia, alleluia!*
Open our heart, O Lord, to accept the words of your Son.
R/. Alleluia!

Gospel Reading:
Luke 10: 38-42 Martha welcomed Jesus into her house. Mary has chosen the better part.
