Behold The Man!

It is our purple and fine linen, our life of ease and our love of wealth, that is mocked today by Christ, the centre of our celebration, who in the presence of Pilate stood like a Lazarus covered with sores and wounds and spoke up as a witness for the truth.

Entrance Antiphon: *O Lord, you had just cause to judge men as you did: because we sinned against you and disobeyed your will. But now show us your greatness of heart, and treat us with your unbounded kindness.*

1st Reading:
Amos 6:1. 4-7 Those who sprawl and those who bawl will be exiled.

Responsorial Psalm *R/. My soul, give praise to the Lord.*

2nd Reading:
1 Timothy 6: 11-1 Do all that you have been told until the Appearing of the Lord.

Gospel Acclamation *R/. Alleluia, alleluia!*
The sheep that belong to me listen to my voice, says the Lord, I know them and they follow me.
R/. Alleluia!

Gospel Reading:
Luke 16: 19-31 Good things came your way, just as bad things came the way of Lazarus. Now he is being comforted here while you are in agony.
