The Lord, The Righteous Judge

The Lord is our judge. The one thing we know for certain about his judgement is that it favours the humble, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.

Entrance Antiphon: Let hearts rejoice who search for the Lord. Seek the Lord and his strength, seek always the face of the Lord.

1st Reading: Ecclesiasticus 35:12-14.16-19 The humble man's prayer pierces the clouds.

Responsorial Psalm R/. This poor man called; the Lord heard him.

2nd Reading: 2 Timothy 4:6-8.16-18 All there is to come now is the crown of righteousness reserved for me.

Gospel Acclamation R/. Alleluia, alleluia! Blessed are you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, for revealing the mysteries of the kingdom to mere children. R/. Alleluia!

Gospel Reading: Luke 18: 9-14 The publican went home at rights with God; the Pharisee did not.
