The Triumph Of God

The day is coming when all that is evil will be brought to nothing. Already Christ has given us the strength to overcome evil: we receive it in the Eucharist.

Entrance Antiphon: The Lord says: my plans for you are peace and not disaster; when you call to me, I will listen to you, and I will bring you back to the place from which I exiled you.

1st Reading: Malachi 3:19-20 For you the sun of righteousness will shine out.

Responsorial Psalm R/. The Lord comes to rule the peoples with fairness.

2nd Reading: 2 Thessalonians 3:7-12 Do not let anyone have food if he refuses to work.

Gospel Acclamation R/. Alleluia, alleluia! Stay awake, praying at all times for the strength to stand with confidence before the Son of Man. R/. Alleluia!

Gospel Reading: Luke 21:5-19 Your endurance will win you your lives.

The wearing of face coverings whilst in church is at the individuals' own discretion. However, I would respectfully ask that people continue to be mindful of the 'personal space' of those who remain anxious and still feel vulnerable.
