COLCHESTER FOOD BANK - THANK YOU FOR HELPING THOSE IN NEED: The Trussell Trust, which operates more than 1,300 foodbanks in the UK, including the Colchester Food Bank, provided 1.5 million emergency food parcels between April and September 2023, a 16% increase from the same period last year. 65% of the parcels were for families with children. The Trussell Trust, The Joseph Rowntree Foundation and other charities are calling on the leaders of UK political parties to support the introduction of an Essentials Guarantee, to ensure that the basic rate of universal credit at least covers life essentials such as food and utility bills. The current standard allowance is only £85 per week for a single person or £134 for a couple; whereas in order to be able to afford essentials such as food and bills it would need to be at least £120 per week for a single person and £200 per week for a couple.
