We celebrate our baptism in the name of the Trinity as a result of which we have received the spirit of sons and are privileged to call the great God of glory and majesty our Father.

*Entrance Antiphon:*                      *Blest be God the Father, and the Only Begotten Son of God, and also the Holy Spirit, for he has shown us his merciful love.*

*1<sup>st</sup> Reading:*  
Deuteronomy 4:32-34,39-40                      The Lord is God indeed, in heaven above as on earth beneath, he and no other.

*Responsorial Psalm*                      **R/. Happy the people the Lord has chosen as his own.**

*2<sup>nd</sup> Reading:*  
Romans 8:14-17                      You received the spirit of sons, and it makes us cry out, 'Abba, Father!'

*Gospel Acclamation*                      **R/. Alleluia, alleluia!**  
*Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, the God who is, who was, and who is to come.*

*Gospel Reading:*  
Matthew 28:16-20                      Baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

**THE POPE'S INTENTIONS FOR MAY:** Let us pray that men and women religious, and seminarians, grow in their own vocational journey through human, pastoral, spiritual and community formation, that leads them to be credible witnesses of the Gospel.

This new lectionary will become mandatory for use in all Catholic parishes and Mass centres in England and Wales, and in Scotland from this coming Advent. The cost of the Ambo Edition of the new lectionary, which comes in four volumes, plus the Processional Edition of Book of the Gospels, will be in the region of £1500. I am inviting/asking for donations to help meet this cost. If you are able to help, please place your donations in an envelope and clearly write 'New Lectionary' on it. If you have registered for Gift Aid please include your assigned number so we can reclaim that valuable, extra 25% from the Government.
