Mary, The Type Of The Church

In Mary, we see the fullness of redemption. Today we celebrate with her, who did the will of God throughout her life and who was the first whom God raised with Jesus and put by his side.

Gospel Reading:

Mark 3:20-35 It is the end of Satan.

THE POPE'S INTENTIONS FOR JUNE: Let us pray that migrants fleeing from war or hunger, forced to undertake journeys fraught with danger and violence, may find a welcome and new living opportunities in their host countries.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION: Every 1st Sunday of the month from 4 – 5^{pm}, beginning with Evening Prayer, we have a Holy Hour of hymns, prayer, and readings before the Blessed Sacrament, *'the source and summit of our faith'*. **Next date: Sunday 7th July.**

NEW LECTIONARY: As I announced earlier this month, the Church's lectionary is being revised to a more faithful translation, reflecting current biblical scholarship.
