SAINTS PETER AND PAUL, Apostles (B)

30th June 2024

(Holyday of Obligation)

We celebrate the feast of the princes of the apostles, from whom we derive our Christian faith. The Lord stood by them and gave them power, so that through them the whole message might be proclaimed for all the world to hear.

Entrance Antiphon: These are the ones who, living in the flesh, planted the Church with their blood; they drank the chalice of the Lord and became the friends of God.

1st Reading: Acts 12:1-11 Now I know the Lord really did save me from Herod.

Responsorial Psalm R/. From all my terrors the Lord set me free.

2nd Reading: Timothy 4:6-8, 17-18 All there is to come now is the crown of righteousness reserved for me.

Gospel Acclamation R/. Alleluia, alleluia!
You are Peter and on this rock I will build my church. And the gates of the underworld can never hold out against it.
R/. Alleluia!

Gospel Reading: Matthew 16:13-19 You are Peter, and I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven.

THE POPE'S INTENTIONS FOR JUNE: Let us pray that migrants fleeing from war or hunger, forced to undertake journeys fraught with danger and violence, may find a welcome and new living opportunities in their host countries.

SECOND COLLECTION – PETER'S PENCE: On the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, we have an opportunity to join Catholics around the world in assisting the Holy Father's emergency relief efforts to the poor, victims of war and natural disasters, migrants and refugees. In the words of Pope Francis '*Let us live in the joyful hope of reciprocating in our brothers and sisters, through the little we can, the abundance we receive from God each day*'.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION: Every 1st Sunday of the month from 4 – 5^{pm}, beginning with Evening Prayer, we have a Holy Hour of hymns, prayer, and readings before the Blessed Sacrament, '*the source and summit of our faith*'. **Next date: Sunday 7th July.**
